## **Funded Transportation Program Suspension**

Arlington, 20 Oct 2005 – Because of a recent series of natural disasters, the Defense Security Cooperation Agency (DSCA) Humanitarian Assistance, Disaster Relief and Mine Action (HDM) office has suspended the [Funded Transportation program](#) until further notice.

The suspension affects all previously approved shipments as well as new transportation requests.

The Funded Transportation program depends on DoD's [Overseas Humanitarian Disaster and Civic Aid \(OHDACA\)](#) funding, all of which is currently allocated to sustain DoD's ongoing humanitarian operations in Pakistan and Guatemala.

This is not the first time the Funded Transportation Program has been suspended this calendar year. A similar measure was taken to support DoD relief efforts after a Tsunami destroyed coastal areas in Asia and Africa last December.

The hold does not affect the [Denton Transportation program](#) which provides transportation for humanitarian cargo using military assets on a space-available basis.
